



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporary Towpath Closure  
Rear of Ham Street Car Park,**

(Reference 24/087)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate environmental agency works at Teddington Lock they intend to make a temporary Notice, the effect of which is to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic and pedestrians on a length of the towpath along the River Thames at the rear of Ham Street Car Park.
2. Whilst the works take place no person shall enter or proceed in the riverside towpath from a point at the north- west corner of Ham street car park westwards for a distance of 30 metres.
3. The Notice will come into effect on 03 June 2024. The restrictions will be in force at all times from 03 June 2024 until 03 December 2024, or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.
4. An alternative route for pedestrians will be provided around the compound.
5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used, or any person in connection with the execution of the said works;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
  - (c) any vehicle being used, or any person needing access for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
