ARRAGON ROAD AND CHURCH STREET, TWICKENHAM

(Reference 24/130)

- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames hereby gives notice that on 22 July 2024 they made the above-named Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the Order is to facilitate the holding of a music festival in Twickenham.
- 3. From 9am until 11.59pm on Sunday 28 July 2024,
 - (a) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in Arragon Road between its junctions with York Street and Church Street.
 - (b) no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Church Street between its junctions with Water Lane and Arragon Road.
 - (c) Church Lane Car Park will be closed all day.
 - (d) York House Car Park will be closed all day.
- 4. A signed diversion route for traffic affected by the closures will be available in adjacent streets.
- 5. Nothing in this Order will apply to:
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
 - (b) any vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker, whereby it is necessary by reason of an emergency, for that vehicle to have access to part of the street under restriction.
- 6. The prohibitions or restrictions specified in this notice will apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 6.. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
