



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Towpath Closure  
PROW No. 157 The Thames Towpath, Kew**

(Ref: 24/186)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that due to the collapse of the riverbank they have made a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a towpath closure in a length of the Thames Towpath, Kew PROW 157.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may proceed in PROW157, Thames Towpath, between Brentford Ferry Gate and the footbridge at Richmond Lock and Weir.
3. The order will come into effect on 14 November 2024. The order will remain in force for a period of 6 months.
4. An alternative route for persons affected by the closure will be available via Twickenham Road and Kew Road.
5. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
  - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
