  - (i) introduce a restricted zone, operating at all times in Watt's Lane, Teddington from a point outside No. 10 Watt's Lane to its northern extremity
  - (b) introduce waiting restrictions, operating at any time, in Watt's Lane from its junction with High Street, Teddington to a point outside No. 10 Watt's Lane.
