



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Waiting Restrictions
Gostling Road, Twickenham**

(Reference 25/049)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to remove obstructive parking and due to the likelihood of danger to the public, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Gostling Road, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the Order is in effect, No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand at any time in Gostling Road, on its north-eastern side, from a point outside the north-western boundary of No. 4 Gostling Road, south-eastwards for a distance of 16 metres.
3. The order will come into effect on 14 April 2025. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months.
4. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
5. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for Police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
