- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames propose to make the above Order under section 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of the **Waiting and Loading Restriction Amendment Order** will be to introduce lengths of yellow lines as set out in the schedule to this Notice.
- 3. The general effect of the **Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools Order** is to introduce School Keep Clear Markings in High Street, Hampton, as detailed in the Schedule to this Notice.

## **SCHEDULE**

Street	Details
A316 Service Road between Redway Drive and Chase Gardens, Twickenham:	To introduce double yellow lines (" no waiting at any time") restrictions on the A316 Service Road between Redway Drive and Chase Gardens, Twickenham.
Brook Road, Twickenham:	To remove 3 metres of parking space outside Nos. 24/26 Brook Road and replace with double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") to allow access to the fire hydrant.
Carrington Road/Manor Road junction, Richmond:	To introduce double yellow lines (" no waiting at any time") restrictions around the junction of Carrington Road, Richmond.
Cedar Avenue, Twickenham:	To upgrade the existing single yellow lines at the cul de sac end of Cedar Avenue to double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time").
Cleves Road, Ham:	To introduce double yellow lines )"no waiting at any time") on the north-west and north-east sides of Cleves Road and around the junction with Back Lane.
Craig Road, Ham:	To introduce 3 metres of double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") on the north-eastern side of Craig Road, opposite Nos. 41 & 43.
Hampton Road, Teddington:	To introduce 3 metres of double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") around the Hampton Road/Gloucester Road junction and outside the vehicle crossover at No. 24 Hampton Road.
High Street, Hampton and Oldfield Avenue, Hampton:	To introduce School, Keep Clear Markings outside Twickenham Preparatory School operating on Monday to Friday between 8.30am and 9.30am and between 2.30pm and 5.30pm, and to upgrade the existing single yellow line to double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") adjacent to No. 51 Hampton Road, in Oldfield Avenue.
High Street and Thames Street, Hampton:	To upgrade the existing single yellow lines to double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") at the High Street/Thames Street junction

Briar Close, Hampton; Crane Park Road, Twickenham, Oldfield Road, Hampton; Thamesgate Close, Ham and Udney Park Road, Teddington:	To introduce various lengths of double yellow lines (no waiting at any time") to facilitate access for emergency vehicles.
Lower Sunbury Road and Lower Hampton Road, Hampton:	To introduce double yellow lines )"no waiting at any time") in Lower Sunbury Road, between its junction with Upper Sunbury Road and the Borough boundary.
Oldfield Road, Hampton:	To introduce double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") on the eastern and western sides of Oldfield Road, so that they operate along the complete length of both those sides.
River Lane and Petersham Road, Petersham:	To introduce double yellow lines )"no waiting at any time") on the northern side of Petersham Road at its junction with River Lane.
Sandy Lane, Teddington:	To introduce double yellow lines )"no waiting at any time") on the northern side of Sandy Lane to east of the junction with Shaef Way.
Tangier Road, Richmond:	To introduce double yellow lines )"no waiting at any time") outside and opposite No. 5 Tangier Road to facilitate access.
