ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Towpath Closure Rear of Ham Street Car Park,

(Reference 25/134)

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate environmental agency works at Teddington Lock they intend to make a temporary Notice, the effect of which is to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic and pedestrians on a length of the towpath along the River Thames at the rear of Ham Street Car Park.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person shall enter or proceed in the riverside towpath from a point at the north- west corner of Ham Street car park westwards for a distance of 30 metres.
- 3. The Notice will come into effect on 08 August 2025. The restrictions will be in force for up to 6 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 4. An alternative route for pedestrians will be provided around the compound.
- 5. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 6. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used, or any person in connection with the execution of the said works;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used, or any person needing access for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
