Gostling Road and Springfield Road, Twickenham:	To introduce double yellow lines (" no waiting at any time") restrictions around the junction of Gostling Road and Springfield Road.
Kew Gardens Road, Kew	To upgrade existing single yellow line restrictions on Kew Gardens Road (including a short length of Sandycombe Road) to double yellow lines 'AT ANY TIME' parking restrictions.
Richmond Road Slipway, Twickenham:	To introduce double yellow lines ("no waiting at any time") on the south-side of the slipway, and to remove the pay and display footway parking at the

	same location.
Briar Close, Hampton; Crane Park Road, Twickenham, Oldfield Road, Hampton; Plevna Road, Hampton; Tulip Close and Jonquil Gardens, Hampton, Thamesgate Close, Ham and Udney Park Road, Teddington:	To introduce various lengths of double yellow lines (no waiting at any time") to facilitate access for emergency vehicles.
