



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

Temporary Road Closure Dynevor Road, The Vineyard & Royston Road, Richmond.

(Reference 25/238)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate gas main replacement works, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in George Street, Richmond.
2. Whilst the works take place no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in the following roads on the following dates:

Road Name:	Closure Location:	Dates:
Dynevor Road	At the junction of Church Road	05/01/26 -16/01/26
The Vineyard	At the junction of Church Road	12/01/26- 23/01/26
Royston Road	At the junction of Church Road	19/01/26- 30/01/26

3. Whilst the road is closed an alternative route for diverted traffic will be available via:
Dynevor Road – Mount Ararat Road – Paradise Road – Sheen Road – Church Rd
The Vineyard – Mount Ararat Road – Paradise Road – Sheen Road – Church Road
Royston Road – Mount Ararat Road – Church Road
4. There will also be rolling suspensions On Church Road Richmond from junction of Sheen Road to the junction of Mount Ararat Road from 05 January 2026 to 15 February 2026.
5. The order will come into effect on 05 January 2026. These works are anticipated to be in progress from 05 January to 15 February 2026. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
6. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
7. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in

- uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for Police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- 8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
