

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Footpath Closure
Mornington Walk, Ham.**

(Ref: 26/003)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate wall replacement works they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a footpath closure of Mornington Walk, Ham.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may proceed in Mornington Walk footpath from the junction with Ham common to the junction with Mornington Walk .
3. The order will come into effect on 12 January 2026. The works are expected to be in progress from 12 January until 23 January 2026 the order will remain in force for a period of 6 months.
4. An alternative route for persons affected by the closure will be available via Craig Road and New Road and vice versa.
5. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
