

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)****Temporary Road Closure  
Avenue Road & Plenva Road, Hampton.**

(Reference 26/004)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate CCTV Survey works, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Plenva Road & Avenue Road, Hampton.
2. Whilst the works take place no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in Plenva Road, Hampton at the junction with Station Road on the 12 January 2026 and Avenue Road at the junction with Station Road on 13 January 2026.
3. There will be parking suspensions in place on Station Road as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
4. Whilst the works take place, an alternative route for diverted traffic will be available via Station Road, Plevna Road, Varna Road, Avenue Road and vice versa.
5. The order will come into effect on 12 January 2026 These works are anticipated to be in progress at night only from 19.00 to 23.00 on 12 January 2026 and 13 January 2026 The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
6. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
7. Nothing in the Order applies to:
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
  - (c) any vehicle being used for Police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
