



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Footpath Closure
PROW23 Malthouse Passage, Barnes.**

(Ref: 26/007)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate telecoms works they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a footpath closure of PROW23 Malthouse Passage, Barnes.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may proceed in PROW23 Malthouse Passage, Barnes from the junction with Cleveland Gardens Westwards for a distance 35 metres.
3. The order will come into effect on 22 January 2026. The works are expected to be in progress on 22 January 2026 only the order will remain in force for a period of 6 months.
4. An alternative route for persons affected by the closure will be available via Malthouse Passage, The Terrace, Cleveland Gardens.
5. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) emergency service vehicles, subject to site conditions at the time of any emergency.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
