



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporary Footpath Closure
Old Station Passage, Richmond.**

(Ref: 26/043)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate emergency works they have made a temporary Traffic Notice, the effect of which will be to introduce a footpath closure of Old Station Passage, Richmond
2. Whilst the works take place no person may proceed in Old Station Passage footpath, Richmond from the junction with Parkshot to the junction with Kew Road.
3. The Notice will come into effect on 05 March 2026. The works are expected to be in progress from 05 March until 06 March 2026 only the Notice will remain in force for a period of 5 days.
4. An alternative route for persons affected by the closure will be available via Parkshot, Little Green, Duke Street, The Quadrant and vice versa.
5. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for Police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
