

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Waiting Restrictions
Larches Avenue & Sheen Lane, East Sheen.**

(Reference 26/053)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate development works, they intend to make a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a temporary prohibition of traffic in Larches Avenue & Sheen Lane, East Sheen.
2. Whilst the works take place, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stand in:-
 - (a) both sides of Larches Avenue from a point east of the crossover serving number 2 Larches Avenue to its eastern extremity between 8.00am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.
 - B) Sheen Lane from its junction with Larches Avenue southwards for a distance of 5 metres where waiting will be prohibited at all times;
 - C) Sheen Lane western side from the termination of the red route south to the north end of the EV parking bay where waiting will be prohibited at all times.
3. The two EV bays on the western side Sheen Lane and the single bay on Sheen Lane from its junction with Larches Avenue southwards for a distance of 5 metres. will be suspended for the duration of the works.
5. The order will come into effect on 06 April 2026. These works are anticipated to be in progress from 06 April 2026 to 28 January 2027. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, to allow for unexpected events and possible remedial works.
6. The prohibitions apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
7. Nothing in the Order applies to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for Police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
