ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (1)

**Temporary Footpath Closure
PROW No. 147 Albany Passage,
Richmond.**

(Ref: 26/064)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate Electrical works they have made a temporary Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a footpath closure in a length of the PROW No. 147 Albany Passage, Richmond.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may proceed in PROW 147, Albany Passage, from a point rear of number 64 to 74 Houblon Road Richmond.
3. The order will come into effect on 21 April 2026. And will be in force at all times on 21 April 2026 only. The order will remain in force for a period of 6 months.
4. An alternative route for persons affected by the closure will be available via Houblon Road & Albany Passage.
5. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
6. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for Police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
7. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
