
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 16A

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) (SPECIAL EVENTS) (TEDDINGTON FAIR) ORDER 2026

Langham Road, Teddington.

(Reference 26/106)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames hereby gives notice that on 30 June 2026 they made the above-named Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order is to facilitate the holding of the “Teddington Fair” event in Twickenham.
3. From 8am until 8pm on Sunday 05 July 2026, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed, wait or stand in Langham Road, in the parking bay in front of the dropped kerb opposite no 16 Langham Road Teddington so that access can be maintained to and from Udney Hall Gardens.
4. Nothing in this Order will apply to:
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a Police Constable, Police Community Support Officer or a Civil Enforcement Officer.
 - (b) any vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker, whereby it is necessary by reason of an emergency, for that vehicle to have access to part of the street under restriction;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for Police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
5. The prohibitions or restrictions specified in this notice will apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
