

The London of Richmond upon Thames (Prescribed Route) (Banned Right Turn) Order 202*

KING STREET, TWICKENHAM

(Reference 26/121)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, proposes to make the above Order under sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order is to introduce a banned right turn for vehicular traffic from Water Lane into King Street, Twickenham.
3. Copies of particulars giving further details of the scheme: -
 - (a) can be inspected, quoting Reference 26/121, at the Civic Centre (Central Reception, ground floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays; and

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, , in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Prescribed Route) (Banned Right Turn) Order 2025 and shall come into operation on *****
2. In this Order –
 - (1) The expression “enactment” means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. At all times, ,no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in a north-westerly direction in Water Lane, upon reaching the junction with King Street .to turn right.
4. Noting in this Order will apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicle being used for Police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) any person who causes or permits any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

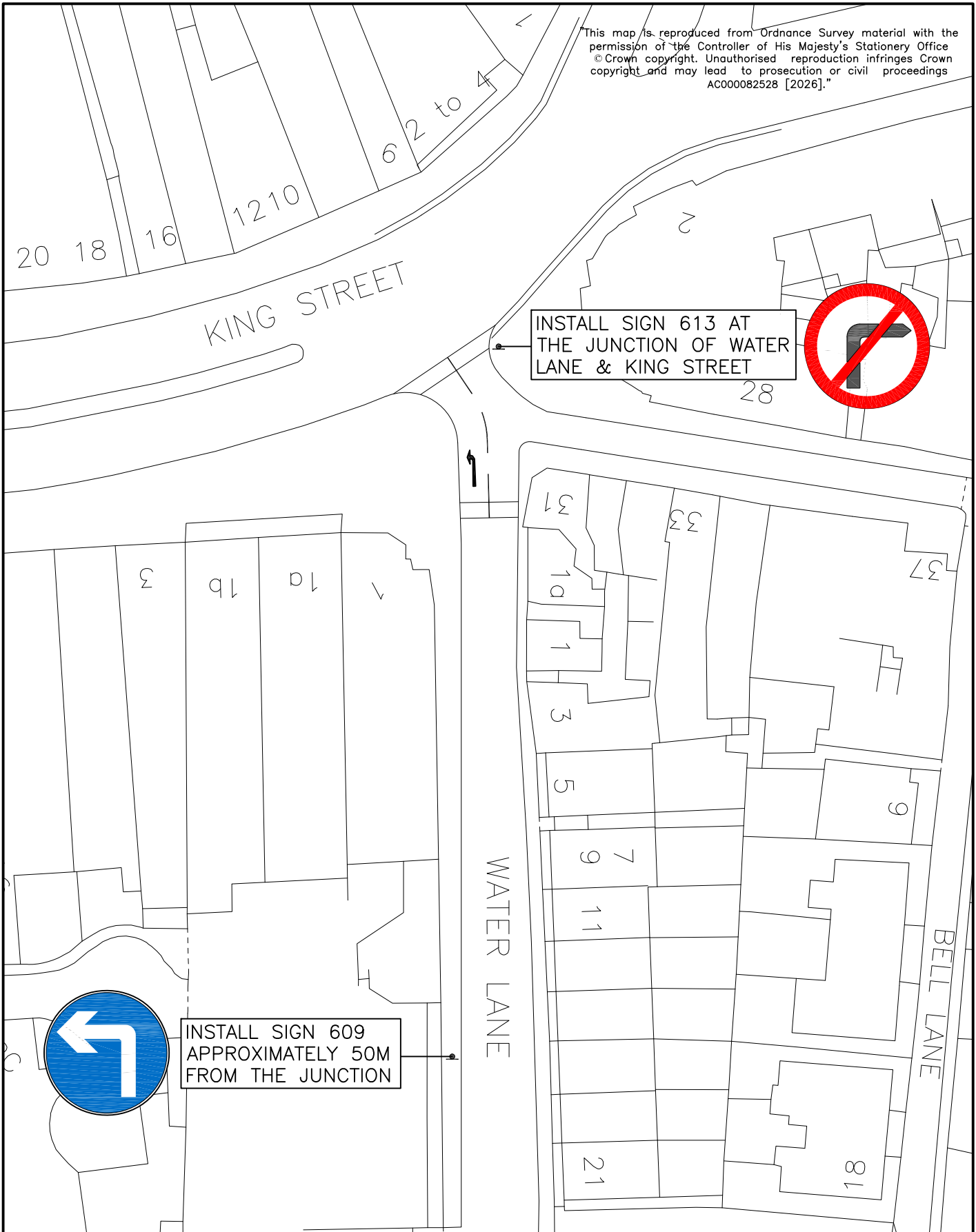
