

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 16A

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) (SPECIAL EVENTS) (THE JOLLY COOPERS ANNIVERSARY) ORDER 2026

High Street Hampton, Hampton.

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames hereby gives notice that on 21 July 2026 they made the above-named Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order is to facilitate the holding of an Anniversary Party at the Jolly Gardners Public house in High Street, Hampton.
3. From 9am on Saturday 25 July 2026 until 11.59pm.

No person may permit a vehicle to wait or stand in High Street Hampton from the junction with Station Road to the junction with Mount Mews

4. Nothing in this Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for Police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes
5. The prohibitions or restrictions specified in this notice will apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 6.. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
