THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES
(BOROUGH-WIDE) (20mph SPEED LIMIT) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 202*

**20 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT
PARTS OF HAMPTON WICK HIGH STREET, HAMPTON COURT ROAD AND CHURCH
GROVE.**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames propose to make the above Order under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The general effect of the **20 MPH SPEED LIMIT AMENDMENT ORDER** will be to introduce a 20 mile per hour speed limit in the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames in all lengths of High Street, Hampton Wick, Hampton Court Road and Church Grove, in the vicinity of Kingston Bridge Roundabout. The speed limit is currently 30 miles per hour in these lengths of road.
3. Copies of the proposals, a plan showing the location and effect of the Order and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order:-
 - (a) can be inspected, quoting Reference 26/168, at the Civic Centre (Central Reception, ground floor), 44 York Street, Twickenham between 9.15am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, except for Bank and other public holidays; and

4.
