



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 (2)

**Temporary Road Closure
Heath Gardens, Twickenham.**

(Ref: 26/188)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate emergency works they have made a temporary Traffic Notice, the effect of which will be to introduce a road closure in Heath Gardens, Twickenham.
2. Whilst the works take place no person may proceed in Heath Gardens, Twickenham from the junction with Heath Road to the junction with Radnor Gardens.
3. There will be rolling suspensions in place for the duration of the works as per prescribed signs.
4. The Notice will come into effect on 16 September 2026. The works are expected to be in progress from 16 September until 30 September 2026 only the Notice will remain in force for a period of 15 days.
5. An alternative route for persons affected by the closure will be available via Heath Road, Radnor Road, Radnor Gardens and vice versa.
6. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
7. Nothing in the Notice will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works or any public service or utility vehicle;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer; or
 - (c) any vehicle being used for Police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
8. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by the Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
