## Appendix 1

## Costs Refusal

### 12 - Exemption where the cost of compliance exceeds appropriate limit

(1)Section 1(1) does not oblige a public authority to comply with a request for information if the authority estimates that the cost of complying with the request would exceed the appropriate limit."

The appropriate limit has been set at  $\pounds$ 450 and may include working hours of any person acting on our behalf at a rate of  $\pounds$ 25 per hour. This equates to 18 hours to locate and extract the relevant information.
