12 - Exemption where the cost of compliance exceeds appropriate limit

(1)Section 1(1) does not oblige a public authority to comply with a request for information if the authority estimates that the cost of complying with the request would exceed the appropriate limit."

The appropriate limit has been set at £450 and may include working hours of any person acting on our behalf at a rate of £25 per hour. This equates to 18 hours to locate and extract the relevant information.

In order to retrieve this data it would be necessary to review 139 separate case records. We estimate it would take 15 minutes per case to ascertain if the case was relevant to this request or not. This equates to approximately 34 hours which clearly exceeds the above stated appropriate limit.

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 this letter acts as a Refusal Notice.
